## Our new theme is 'Can I tell you a story?'

We will be reading traditional stories such the 'The Little Red Hen', 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears', and 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff.' We will share different versions of these stories and compare them. We will learn to retell the stories using story language, perform them using story maps and songs and use them as inspiration for our artwork.

We will also share stories important to different cultures such as the Ramayana and the Nativity.

We are excited to be starting a new initiative called 'Drawing Club'. Some of the benefits are that:

- Vocabulary is introduced in a contextual way
