How can you help?

- Please listen to your child read as often as possible, we recommend at least 3 times a week. Reading
 books will be checked and changed every day. Please record all reading in your child's reading record
 and make sure that this, along with their reading books, are brought into school every day. We love to
 hear your children read as often as we can.
- Please help your child to prepare for their Show and Tell if you can, each child will receive a date to present their show and tell once throughout the half-term. Please avoid bringing in special belongings or toys on other days, unless this has been agreed to support transition from home to school.
- Provide your child with a bag for school every day, ideally one which can fit A4 letters and books, a water bottle and a reading wallet **book bags are great for this!**
- Details of our learning in Phonics will be sent home and posted on Class Dojo every week this shows the sounds that we are learning, some of the words that we are reading, the sentences we will be writing and the spellings we're focusing on that week. You can help your child by reading and writing these words and sentences.
- Please provide your child with a PE kit inside a pump bag to be kept in school. Your child's PE kit should consist of blue shorts and a white t-shirt. Please pop your child's name in their PE kit.
- Please provide your child with a named water bottle from home to use daily.

Feel free to catch us for a chat and ask any questions, we are always happy to help. Miss Lund will be on the door in the mornings and Miss Woodhurst will be at the end of the school day.
