English

We will be learning to read a range of books with fluency and expression. The children will continue to focus upon accuracy when writing. using words banks and sound mats to support their spelling and regular handwriting practice to ensure their writing is well presented. Our English learning will be inspired by 'No Dinner' and 'The Jolly Christmas Postman'. We will be learning how to create story maps to help us when retelling a story and writing our own narratives.

Maths

We will all be learning about Place Value, Addition, Subtraction and about 2D and 3D Shapes. The children will learn to recognise and read numbers up to 100.

Little Oaks will be focusing on understanding the place value of numbers to 20 and calculating with these numbers. Big Oaks will continue to calculate and solve problems with numbers up to 100.

Physical Education

In PE we will be taking part in ball skills run by Project Sport on a Monday and learning to become fabulous skippers with Dave in SKIP2BFIT on Fridays.

Science
