Acorns



Acorns have had a fabulous start to the Spring term welcoming their new class members and making friends.

We have been learning all about animals and reflecting on what makes animals amazing. The children's knowledge, questioning and vocabulary has been incredible! Take a look at what they know and want to know.

We began by exploring the Arctic and researching which animals live there, we are now reading 'Poles Apart' and making maps and small world re-creations of the Arctic and Antarctic. Ask the children why polar bears and penguins never meet in the wild.

# **Oaks**
